The James L. Thompson Scholarship is named for a former, now deceased, Chair of the Ministry of Deacons here at Mt. Olivet. He served many years. He was committed to his church and to the education of young people.

Mt. Olivet Baptist Church provides an opportunity for qualified students who are pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree **to receive a \$1000.00 award (\$500.00 per semester).** The scholarship criteria follows:

Requirements for FIRST YEAR students (entering first-year students) OR upper-class students who HAVE NOT been awarded a James L. Thompson scholarship previously:

- Student must be an active disciple or participant at Mt. Olivet Baptist Church and a regular attendee (in-person or on-line).
- Students must be accepted into an accredited 2-year or 4-year institution or graduate school or accredited trade or vocational school. <u>If you are a</u> <u>first-year student, a letter of acceptance from the institution</u> <u>must be a part of your application packet.</u>
- Provide the **most recent official transcript**. The transcript must **not** be opened and must be submitted to the attention of:

- Must have a cumulative minimum grade point average of 2.0. Grade point averages are computed on a 4.0 scale.
- If you are applying for the Friend-Gardner-Love scholarship, one **official transcript** will suffice for both.
- Submit a no more than 2-page, double spaced essay which describes what you plan to do with your education. See page 4 for the topic.
- Complete the demographic information page.

REQUIREMENTS FOR RETURNING STUDENTS (previously awarded a JLT Scholarship)

- Student must be an active disciple or participant at Mt. Olivet Baptist Church and a regular attendee (in-person or on-line).
- Must attend a 2- or 4-year accredited institution, an accredited. graduate school or accredited trade or vocational school.
- Must have a cumulative 2.3 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Provide an official transcript, mailed from the institution to the attention of:

- One transcript will suffice if you are applying for the Friend-Gardner-Love scholarship.
- Have completed ten hours of community service during the academic year.
- Provide a statement from the person who can verify your 10 hours of community service. That statement should be written on the letterhead of the organization. It should include a description of your volunteer duties, including the number of volunteer hours and must be signed by an individual who is knowledgeable of your work. Include in your application packet.
- Complete an essay about your community service. Topic is on page 5.
- Complete the demographic information page.

Late applications may not receive consideration. Scholarship packets must be returned to the church office or directly to Dr. Harris (<u>drgeniet@sbcglobal.net</u> or in person) no later than May 12, 2024. The scholarship committee will review thoroughly all scholarship applications.
